The sun is out, the flowers are blooming, and Oliver and Clover can't wait to explore! Spring is full of new things to discover. A curious Safety Pup keeps their eyes open and their heart ready for adventure!



COME ON

OLIVER!

Oliver spots something interesting by the trail! But wait – a Safety Pup doesn't touch a plant until they know what it is. Leaves of three? Let it be! When Oliver isn't sure, he looks with his eyes, not his paws.



GOOD BOY

OLIVER!

Oliver and Clover are exploring near the creek when Oliver spots something in the grass. He stops. He stays still. He doesn't get closer. A Safety Pup knows that some animals are best watched from far away – and that's okay!



GOOD EYE

OLIVER!

Oliver loves splashing in the creek! But a Safety Pup always checks first – is the water moving fast? Is it deeper than it looks? Oliver stays where his paws can touch the bottom and always makes sure his grown-up knows where he is.



GOOD BOY

OLIVER!

Oops! Oliver didn't see the ant hill and now his paw is stinging!
Clover was watching where she stepped and stayed back. Oliver
remembers Safety Pups watch where they step. Some little things
can cause big ouches!



WATCH OUT

OLIVER!

After a morning of exploring, it's time for a tick check! Oliver holds still while his person looks through his fur. It's not the most fun part of the day, but Safety Pups know that checking for ticks after being outside keeps everyone healthy.



GOOD BOY

OLIVER!

The sun is hot and Oliver and Clover have been playing all morning!
A Safety Pup knows when it's time to find some shade, drink some
water, and take a break. Taking care of yourself is part of the
adventure too!



GOOD JOB

OLIVER!

The sky is getting dark and Oliver hears a rumble. Thunder means lightning, and lightning means it's time to go inside – now! A Safety Pup doesn't wait to see if the storm gets closer. When you hear it, it's time to go inside.



LET'S GO

OLIVER!

Oliver and Clover run for the barn as the rain starts falling! They know where to go because a Safety Pup always knows where the nearest safe place is. Inside a building – not under a tree, not in an open field. Inside!



GOOD JOB

OLIVER!

Sometimes the best adventures happen inside! Oliver and Clover don't mind the rain – there are books to read, pictures to draw, and cozy spots to share. A Safety Pup knows that a quiet day is still a good day.



GOOD BOY

OLIVER!

A Safety Pup knows when it's safe to come back out – when the sky is clear and the thunder has stopped. Patience is part of being safe too.

The storm is over and the puddles are calling! Oliver and Clover splash and play in the golden light. What a big day – they explored, they learned, they stayed safe, and now they’re celebrating. That’s what curious Safety Pups do. See you next adventure!

Note to Parents:

While Oliver and Clover's adventures take place around barns, creeks, fields, and spring storms, the lessons in this book can travel anywhere. Not every child grows up near a creek bank or a pasture gate, but every child can learn to pause, notice what is around them, and ask for help when something feels unsafe.

This book is about more than outdoor safety. It is about raising thoughtful, steady little people – kids who learn to respect nature, give animals space, stay calm when plans change, and understand that being careful is not the same as being afraid. Sometimes the bravest choice is stepping back, waiting out the storm, or noticing the tiny warning signs before rushing ahead.

Those lessons start small, with a dog, a lamb, and a coloring page.

But they grow with your child.

If a particular page sparks a conversation, follow it. You do not have to have the perfect words. Just be there. That's what Oliver would do.
